Jamaica

The Island is full of annual festivities including the breathtaking 'Battle of Britain International Air display' and the Mardi Gras style 'Battle of Flowers' but one of the most special attractions is the world famous Gerald Durrell Wildlife sanctuary and the World Class team get to meet some of its residents!

London - England

One of the most famous and historic cities in the world, a city that will keep the most demanding of jet set travellers happy - for a lifetime!

The Algarve - Portugal.

No 'World Class' trip could be complete without visiting the country that gave us navigation – Portugal. On the south of the country sits the Algarve with its clear waters and sandstone cliffs that make this coastline truly stunning.

Stockholm and Jukkasjärvi

The Magical city of Stockholm, the capital of Sweden - a real treat for those who wish to travel in style!

We take a cruise on the Birka Paradise out of Nordic Venice through an archipelago of twenty four thousand islands, then head to the deep freeze of Jukkasjarvi a little town that's 200 miles into the Arctic Circle and the home of the world famous 'Ice Hotel.

Its a land of huskies, skidoos and of course the Absolute Vodka bar!

Where we stayed:

We stayed in award winning 'Victory Hotel' in Stockholm and the really cool Ice Hotel in Jukkasjarvi.

The Victory Hotel is a welcoming and exclusive hotel with a personal atmosphere in the perfect location of Gamla Stan, Stockholm's charming Old Town.

Actually the hotel is a tourist attraction in itself. It contains a unique, private collection of marine antiques, passionately selected by the collector himself, the hotel's founder and owner Gunnar Bengtsson.

Botswana - Africa

In this episode we don't have just one World Class destination... We visit three remarkable Safari camps in Botswana, Africa.

If your wanting a relaxing holiday on the beach, then this isn't the place for you.

Traditionally we stayed under canvas, but they were no ordinary tents. Each camp is unique as in offers an alternative view of luxury accommodation, but it certainly meets that World Class grade with ease!

Cape Town & Johannesburg - South Africa

The Famous Mount Nelson Hotel (affectionately known as Nellie, to those in the know) plays host to our team in Cape Town.

The hotel recently celebrated its 100th birthday and remains as 'the' place to stay in this colourful city.

In Johannesburg our crew stayed in The Westcliff an amazing property that overlooks a valley of Jacarandas and the zoo.

Mauritius - Indian Ocean
